

Consent to process your application

Version 2.5, updated 8 August 2018

In signing this declaration of consent, you give your **explicit consent** for the Carlsberg Foundation (hereinafter also the “data controller” or “we”) to collect and process your personal data, including your application, for use in:

- 1) Assessing whether the Carlsberg Foundation will award a grant to you or your project.
- 2) Sharing your submitted application, in its entirety, with specialists who are connected with the Foundation or consulted as part of the application processing.

What data?

- Basic data such as name, address, e-mail, telephone number.
- Details and description of the project, budget for the project, bank details, job title.
- Other relevant data that you may otherwise provide in your attached application.

It is **mandatory** for you to give your consent for processing of the above data if you want your application to be processed and assessed. If you do not give your consent for processing, we cannot process your application for a grant.

Duration of consent

The consent applies for six months from today’s date. Once we have processed your application for a grant, your data will be processed on a different basis. Concerning public disclosure of your personal data

If you receive a grant from us, you should be aware that certain general data can **be publicly disclosed without your consent**. Specifically, we can publicly disclose general personal data such as name and job title, as well as the amount of the grant and other details of the project. The purpose of the public disclosure is to discuss what the Foundation supports and your specific project. This public disclosure is carried out on a basis other than your consent, cf. GDPR art. 6, para. 1(f) (balancing of interests) and art. 6, para. 1(b) (necessary for fulfilling an agreement).

Your rights

You may, at any time, withdraw the consent you have given to the data controller, the Carlsberg Foundation, CVR no. 60223513, located in H.C. Andersens Boulevard 35, 1553 Copenhagen V, Denmark. Your declaration of consent can be withdrawn by contacting Rasmus Enevoldsen by telephone on +45 33435363 or by e-mail to re@carlsbergfoundation.dk.

If you choose to withdraw your consent, it will not affect the legality of our processing of your personal data based on your previously given consent up to the time that consent is withdrawn. If you withdraw your consent, it will only therefore take effect from that time.

You can contact the Carlsberg Foundation to access the personal data concerning you that we are processing, and you can have any inaccurate personal data rectified. If you wish to have personal data erased, have the processing of the data restricted, object to the processing of the data or take advantage of the right to data portability, you can contact us.
